Storm Debris Drop-Off Site

The City of Bonney Lake is accepting branch debris from residents inside Bonney Lake city limits from January 24th through February 5th from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily at the gravel boat launch parking lot, also known as Ball Park 4, located on the north side of Bonney Lake Blvd E across from Allan Yorke Park (19500 Bonney Lake Blvd E). Signs will be placed en route to guide citizens to the site. Citizens are encouraged to take Locust Avenue to reach Bonney Lake Blvd due to construction on West Lake Tapps Hwy.

- **This drop-off site is for use by residents of the City of Bonney Lake only.**
- **Debris shall consist of tree limbs only.**
- **Limbs shall be no longer than 8' (pick-up box length), and shall be no larger than a 10" diameter.**
- **No landscape contractors, garbage, construction debris or stumps will be allowed.**
- **This service will be available from Tuesday, January 24th through Sunday, February 5th, 2012 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**
