Upon completion of the SEPA review, then the Joint Aquatic Resource Permits Application (JARPA) application will be sent to the Department of Fish and Wildlife. Once the JARPA application is approved and you have received the permit from Puget Power, the Planning and Community Development Department will issue a shoreline substantial development exemption permit (bulkhead permit).

If the bulkhead is over four feet high, a building permit is required. The fee for the building permit will be based on the valuation of the project. This fee will be collected when a building permit is issued. Please remember, if a building permit is required construction can not begin until the building permit is issued even though a shoreline permit has been issued.
