1. New Councilmember Orientation - CIP Projects. City Engineers Woodcock and Budzynski reviewed the current six year CIP plan with Council members Rackley and Lewis. Council Chair Rackley suggested PW discontinue annual leaky water line surveys until the backlog of leaky water line projects was completed. PW Director Grigsby will review this with PW staff and will provide a response at the next CDC meeting.

III. 2010 Actions Under Development by Staff (Date Action Added)

1. Water Reclamation / Secondary Water System for Irrigation
2. Ordinance - Frontage Maintenance in City Right of Way (Residential and Commercial)
3. Drainage Improvement for 191st East Ave and 79th St. E. Funding is not available to accomplish this project at this time.
4. Ordinance – Eliminate credit for Storm Water Ponds on Commercial Properties. Draft proposal to phase in over A 3-4 YEAR PERIOD.
5. LID – Low Impact Development – Review Design Standards that make LID easier for developers to use.
6. Ordinance – Prohibit placement of recreational equipment (such as basketball hoops) in the public roadway or on sidewalks.
7. Presentation on unaccounted for water (7 Nov 2009)
8. Presentation from old meters to newer touch-radio read meters. (7 Nov 2009)
