

Park Commission Vacancy

The City of Bonney Lake is requesting applications to serve on its Park Commission in a volunteer capacity. There is currently one vacancy. For this position, preference is given to a high school or college student to represent the interests of children and young adults. However, interested persons of all ages are encouraged to apply as applications are kept on file for vacancies as they arise.

The Park Commission is comprised of seven members appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council. The Commission was reorganized in 2004 (Ordinance 1009) and further updated in 2014 (Ordinance 1485).

Park Commission members are charged to study and recommend park policies and rules, assist in the development of the Parks Element of the [Comprehensive Plan](#) and make other recommendations to the Mayor and City Council regarding related systems such as trails. They are to make recommendations from time to time concerning the acquisition, improvement and use of parks, playgrounds and recreational equipment and facilities, including rules and regulations.
